<p>You're a Poet</p> <p>Write a poem about on aspect of the novel, examples include: characters, scenes, situations.</p> <p>Include a brief reflection about how the poem connects to the novel citing textual evidence.</p>	<p>You're a Tweet-er</p> <p>Select 3 letters that are key to the story and communicate the contents of the letters in one of the following ways: Text Message Tweet (140 characters) Email (visible on one screen)</p> <p>Compare the original letters with the new messages. Discuss what was conveyed in the letter but was lost in the shorter version. How might circumstances have been different if they had other methods of communication than letters?</p>	<p>You're a Researcher</p> <p>Investigate and research the social and cultural institutions and attitudes of the Regency Period. What was the English class system like? What was Austen's attitude toward it? Provide evidence from the text to support Austen's attitude.</p> <p>Research Jane Austen's life and write a short biography.</p> <p>You may choose to present your research information in the manner you choose (i.e. paper, PowerPoint, website, book, presentation board, etc.)</p>
<p>You're the Teacher</p> <p>Create a test over <i>Pride and Prejudice</i>. You will need a minimum of 25 questions. You must also provide an answer key.</p>	<p>You're a Playwright</p> <p>Choose a scene from the book and rewrite the scene to reflect modern society. You will need stage directions and dialogue. Make sure you include descriptions of setting and characters in your dialogue.</p> <p>If you choose to act out your scene in class, you will earn extra points. Feel free to recruit other students to read the parts.</p>	<p>You're Emily Post</p> <p>Take what you have learned from <i>Pride and Prejudice</i> and create a book of manners.</p> <p>Use the book to create your manners. You may also research the Regency period to help.</p> <p>Minimum of 10 pages (10 manners).</p>
<p>You're a Wedding Planner</p> <p>Choose one of the couples from the novel and plan out their wedding. You will need to provide information and pictures to represent all the important aspects of a wedding.</p> <p>Research the Regency Period for information about weddings during this time period.</p>	<p>You're an Artist</p> <p>Choose a minimum of 5 characters, scenes, situations, or settings mentioned or described in the novel. Illustrate in a book format your choices. Provide a brief description of each choice using textual evidence.</p>	<p>You're a Writer</p> <p>Write a 1000 word essay over one of the six provided essay topics.</p> <p>See Mrs. Sweeney for approved topics.</p>
